ENCOURAGING WORDS

Oh Those Words!

Words can be disastrous when used in the wrong way on December 20, 2013, a PR executive for internet giant Active Corp tweeted a comment that seemed to link skin color with AIDS. She did so as she was taking off from England for South Africa. During the flight, her tweet was shared over 2,000 times and went viral. By the time she landed, she had lost her job and her name had been forever tainted. Wisdom and discretion would have saved her that fate.

What does the Bible say specifically about social media and its use? Nothing. However, there is wisdom to be found that would guide us in the use of this public platform. The Proverbs teach us several aspects of speech.

There are times when it is best to be silent! "When there are many words, transgression is unavoidable, but he who restrains his lips is wise. (Prov. 10:19) He who guards his mouth and his tongue guards his soul from troubles.

(Prov. 21:23) One must also learn to think before one speaks/ tweets or posts! There is one who speaks rashly like the thrusts of a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

(Prov. 12:18) We need to make sure that our motives are pure. All the ways of a man are clean in his own sight, but the Lord weighs the motives. (Prov. 16:2)

There are many more Proverbs along with several other passages in God's Word to help us with this challenging subject. No matter the time period in man's history there have always been opinions to express, comments to make and injustices to right. We need to make sure that what we publicize matches up with who we claim to be as saints and citizens of heaven. We could lose more than our jobs by our comments, and we do not want to taint the name we wear.
