## ENCOURAGING WORDS

### What Was That Combination Again?

I was hunting around the garage the other day and came across an old combination lock that I had given one of our four to lock up their bikes at school I foolishly attempted to remember the four digit combination (what was it i had for breakfast?) without much luck.

You see, the process required to open one of these locks is very simple– all the numbers must be placed in a precise order.

When any “combination” of (1) the numbers and (2) the right order come together, then and only then will access be granted.

If the 4-digit combination is 1234, then only those numbers in that specific sequence can open the lock. The number 5 is a close number and an all-around nice number, but not a correct number and can never be used to open the lock.

So what does this have to do with me you ask? The most important door that anyone can ever open is the door of salvation, and the only way to “unlock” that door is through following the sequence that God and only God has specified! Following any other “combination” than the one defined by God will leave someone on the outside of that door... forever!

In the New Testament God lovingly gives us His “combination” to secure the access to His promise of Heaven. Believe + Repent + Confess + Baptism is the combination and sequence that will open the door to salvation! This is the one combination that we want to share with everyone!
