ENCOURAGING WORDS

Another Bulletin Article?

I know of a preacher who was once told "I don't know why you bother writing articles for the bulletin, nobody reads them"! If you are reading these words, you are probably in a minority among Christians.

That is not a pessimistic statement, but one of observation and deduction. Remember not all Christians attend Sunday morning worship; fewer come to Bible study and evening assemblies; still fewer actually bring a Bible with them to services; still fewer actually open their Bible during the services, etc. If all of that can be shown to be true, then those who read bulletin articles are surely in an elite selection (albeit, a minority) among Christians. Let me assure you that you are appreciated!

So, among the few who read bulletin articles, what are some of the reasons that they read?

Some read out of curiosity. "What's he going to say today?" "I wonder if there are any mistakes in this week's article, misspelled words or grammatical errors?" "Is he going to get on his soapbox again?" "Is he going to talk about guitars and the 49ers?!" Some folks read because they're curious. If that's you, I'm glad you're reading. Keep coming back!

Some read out of boredom. "I grabbed a bulletin and now I'm just looking through it and waiting for Bible class or worship to start." Some folks read because they're bored. If that's you, I'm glad you're reading. Keep coming back!

Some read for learning/encouragement. "I enjoy the articles and learn a little something from each one.... plus they are way shorter than his sermons!" If that's you, I'm very glad your reading. Please keep coming back!

While I realize there are a multiplicity of reasons that people read bulletin articles, I hope you read to find an opportunity to learn, to grow, to be encouraged, to be drawn closer to God, etc. My articles are not very long and vary from topic to topic, but it's worth a read even if only learn a little something new, or grow a little more, or be encouraged just a small bit or draw just a smidgen closer to God. Whatever your reason for reading, I'm glad you're reading. Please keep coming.
