MONTHLY POTLUCK

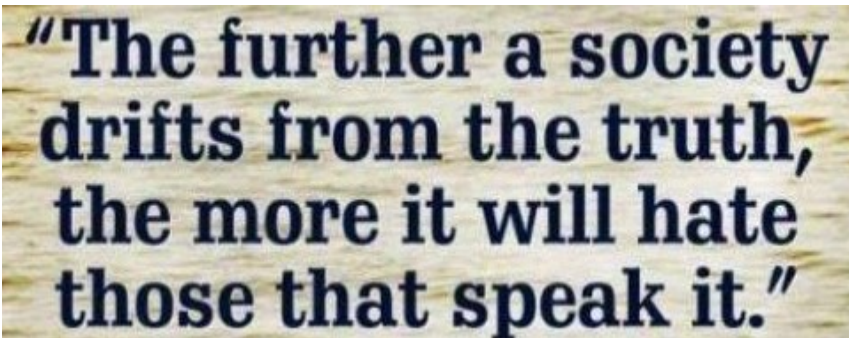
Today after morning services is our monthly potluck. If you have any questions please see Rebecca Casey. A brief message will directly follow the potluck. That will conclude our services for the day.

Thanks for Your Example!

It is no accident, and certainly no mistake, that the Lord designed His church in such a way that males are to fill the leadership roles. Those who lead in worship are males (1 Tim. 2:8-15). Those who preach publicly are males (1 Cor. 14:26-40). Those who are appointed to leadership positions are males (1 Tim. 3:1-7, 8-13; Tit. 1:5-9).

However, it is no accident, and certainly no mistake, that the Lord designed His church in such a way that ladies can and should have a tremendously positive influential impact on the church. In the New Testament, think about **Lois** and **Eunice** (2 Tim. 1:5; Acts 16:1-5) – **Lydia** (Acts 16:13-15, 40) – **Phoebe** (Rom. 16:1-2) – **Priscilla** (Acts 18:1-3, 24-26) – and many others! Although these ladies could not scripturally fulfill specific leadership roles in the church, it did not mean that they were insignificant or had no place of meaningful service in the kingdom. **Quite the opposite!**

How beautiful is the Lord's body and how effective are its efforts when "every part does its share" (Eph. 4:16), men and women alike! I am so thankful for the women I have known in the family of God, who have devoted themselves to being everything they could be in God's roles for them!
