## ENCOURAGING WORDS

### The Best Taste In the World!

What us your very favorite thing to eat? What is it that you crave to the point that you will do almost anything to get a taste of it? Could this possible have a spiritual application? ...."Crave pure spiritual milk, so by it you may grow up in your salvation..."(1Pet. 2:2)

Several years ago there was a man named William McPherson. In a horrible accident, a charge of dynamite went off in his face. He lost his hands, his eyes and the feeling in much of his face. He entered into a world of darkness that he had never known before, and began to crave the Bible more than he had ever before. But he could not read! He was not able to read Braille with his artificial hands. He even tried reading it with his lips, but he had very little feeling in them after the accident. Finally, in his passionate pursuit to read God's Word, he discovered that he could decipher the Moon type system of embossed symbols with his tongue. He painstakingly taught himself to distinguish the various curves, lines, and angles of the system, often taking hours to learn just one letter! His tongue became very sore, raw, and would bleed when he read. But how he longed for God's Word! Over the next 65 years, William McPherson read through the Bible four times with just his tongue!

I wonder sometimes what excuses we use for not reading and studying God's Word as we should. Are we "too busy, too tired, too bored?" Or, do we just not want to do it? If we have a favorite food that we often have a craving for, why does the Living Word, the "Bread of Life" not have that same appeal? The story of William McPherson makes me feel like I don't have any possible excuse at all for not partaking of God's Word as I should...how about you?
