ENCOURAGING WORDS

Out of the Mouths of Babes!

There are times when some of life's greatest lessons can be found in places where we wouldn't think to look. There is a simple song which has been sung by children for many, many years which contains a profound truth. In reality, while it may be thought of as a children's song, those who are older would truly profit if they thought about its message.

*Watch your eyes, watch your eyes what they see.
Watch your eyes, watch your eyes what they see.
For the Father up above is looking down in love,
So watch your eyes, watch your eyes what they see.*

Each succeeding verse is similar but changes the word eye and the word see to point to another part of the body. The children point to each part of the body so there is a lot of action. Those of us who are older could profit, not by physically doing the actions, but by doing the "action" in our hearts.

Watch your eyes, what they see. "The woman saw that the tree was good...pleasant to her eyes" (Gen. 3:6). "All that is in the world...the lust of the eyes...is not of the Father" (1 John 2:16).

Watch your ears, what they hear. "One who turns away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer is an abomination to God" (Pro. 28:9). "Incline your ear to wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding" (Pro. 2:2).

Watch your lips, what they say. "Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit" (Psa. 34:13). "Lying lips are an abomination to the Lord, but those who deal truthfully are His delight" (Pro. 12:22).

Watch your hands, what they do. "My hands also will I lift up to Your commandments, which I love and I will meditate on Your law" (Psa. 119:48). "These six things the Lord hates, yes seven are an abominations to Him...hands what shed innocent blood" (Pro. 6:16-17).

Watch your feet, where they go. "I have restrained my feet from every evil way, that I may keep Your word" (Psa. 119:101). "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light to my path" (Psa. 119:105).
