### ENCOURAGING WORDS

#### Wise Words!

As we have discussed these past few weeks, Solomon is often called the wisest man in the Bible. As a youth, he asked God to give him wisdom, and our amazing God answered his prayer abundantly. If you and I want to share in this wisdom from heaven, we must spend time meditating on the words of this wise king. Consider these three times Divine wisdom says we should consider our "talk."

**Do not talk about helping someone tomorrow when you can help today.** Solomon said, "*Do not say to your neighbor, 'Come back tomorrow and I'll give it to you'— when you already have it with you.*" (**Prov. 3:28**) There are times when you may have to wait about helping another, but Solomon says help a person today if you can. The context of these words has to do with benevolence, but the principle applies to many situations in our lives.

**Do not say that you will "get even" with a person who has wronged you.** *Do not say, "I'll pay you back for this wrong!" Wait for the Lord, and he will avenge you.* (**Prov. 20:22**) How can you turn the other cheek? How can you give food and drink to an enemy? It's very simple. Vengeance belongs to the Lord, and He will always repay (**Rom. 12:19**). There is no need for us to pre-empt God!

**Do not say that you will treat others the way they are treating you.** Listen to Solomon again. "*Do not say, 'I'll do to them as they have done to me; I'll pay them back for what they did.'*" (**Prov. 24:29**) These words are diametrically opposed to the "Golden Rule" given by Jesus. Treating others like they treat you is a message from Satan. We live by a much higher rule, putting ourselves in their place.

If you and I want to be wise like Solomon we need to take time to read what he wrote. Make his words the words which rule your life!
