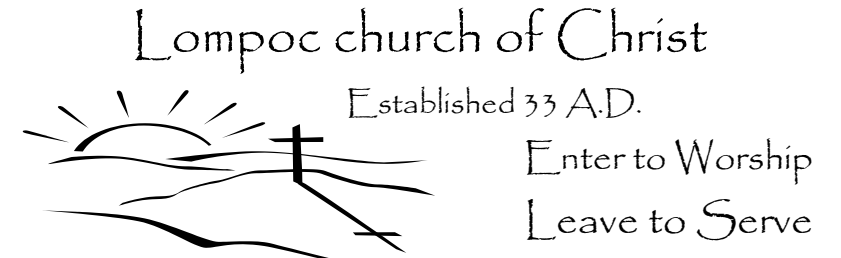

Is Loyalty Always a Good Thing?

I am always amazed then political party loyalty is so ingrained in people that many will vote for their party's candidate regardless of who the person is. There have actually been occasions when voters knowingly voted for a dead man because of their unwavering allegiance to their party!

- Some would never leave their party because it had been the party of their family for generations.
- Some would never listen to the other side regardless of any information that is presented to them, any knowledge that they acquire, or obvious truths or wrong doings that come to light!

Loyalty to one's own religious group or church is much the same as it has been so ingrained in some people that many would never consider leaving their group.

- Some would never leave their religious group / church because it had been the church of their family for generations.
- Some would never listen to opposing points of view regardless of information that is presented to them, any knowledge that they acquire, or obvious truths or wrong doings that come to light!

Ask your self this question....does this describe me? You see, it's important that we put "what we have been taught" and "what we've always believed" under the microscope of God's Word; to put it all to the "test" to "*see whether they are from God.*" (1John 4:1)

I know, these are two topics that you never discuss together....politics and religion, and I've hit them both! But, there is a big difference. One of these topics has no bearing on the eternal destiny of our soul, and the other topic has all bearing on the eternal destiny of our soul. We'd better make sure that we are in the right place!
