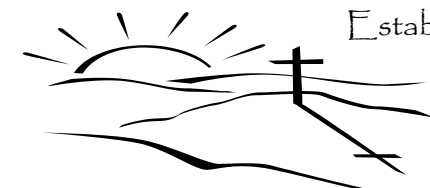

ENCOURAGING WORDS

The "Perfect" Candidate!

There is an expression which has emerged this election season that seems to be apart of our insufferably long campaign process, and that is the phrase "*the lesser of two evils.*" I have heard it applied to our choice in local representation, but more widely used when referring to our choice between the two presidential candidates, but let's avoid that political skirmish for right now. There is in one thing that I would like for you to consider this week as you put this whole election process into prospective and it is this....only Jesus is our perfect candidate!

Jesus wins every time you vote for Him!
