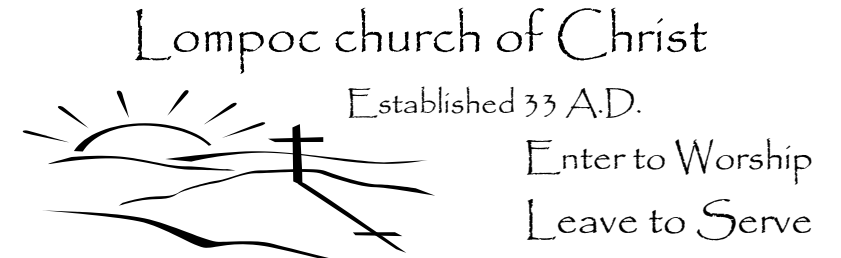

I once heard a story about a man named Ben who had fallen into the habit of grumbling about this and that. He wanted to stop it, but somehow, as soon as anything would not go his way, he found himself grumbling again. Then he came across this verse:

*"When you have truly thanked God
For every blessing sent,
But little time will then remain
For murmur or lament."*
