## ENCOURAGING WORDS

### Rejoicing in the Lord

One of the more challenging verses in Scripture to apply to our life is in Philippians 4:4- "Rejoice in the Lord always." Many a Christian has wondered how this is possible given all the ups and downs of life.

Perhaps the difficulty is that we are focused on the wrong words in this passage. First we notice the challenge of "rejoice" which, at times, can be problematic depending on the circumstance. But, then there is the word "always," which is problematic as well. Still, we are focused on the wrong words. Look for a moment at the three words in between to find the key in fulfilling this command... "in the Lord." so, now we see that the key to "rejoicing always" is to do so "in the Lord!" so how do we do that???? Here are some keys that have to do with the phrase "in the Lord."

To rejoice in the Lord always, I must learn to "**trust in the Lord**" (2:19). The word "trust" in this verse means to have "hope in the Lord" Truly putting my home and my trust in the Lord will help me to rejoice in the Lord... always!

To rejoice in the Lord always, I must stand "**firm in the Lord**" (4:1). The word means to stand firm, to hold ones ground, like a soldier determined not to budge one inch from his post. Standing firm **with** and **for** the Lord will help me to prepare in the Lord... always! Remember that rejoicing is not "in the world" but "in the Lord"!
