ENCOURAGING WORDS

Preaching Christ

As we look the decaying godly values of our society. Much of it can be traced back to our religious world. Many have lost sight of the power of the story of the coming Messiah. His death, His burial, His resurrection and the establishment of His kingdom to bring salvation to the world. This was the message that began at Pentecost and spread around the world! In this day, far too many give their "testimony" about their past life and how they have changed. The message that will strengthen our nation and convert the world is not the story of *our* life, but the story of *His* life!

In Acts chapter 8, we read about how Philip lead lost men to Jesus. It was not the "testimony" of Philip's past life that changed the world, but it was the story of the Savior! As Philip approached the eunuch who was reading from the book of the prophet Isaiah...

Then both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water and Philip baptized him.
