### **ENCOURAGING WORDS**

#### **Our Worship Together**

Worship is an interesting subject to discuss, as there seem to be so many varied ideas about what is or is not acceptable worship. Some take a very open approach and suggest that "how" one worships really is not all that important, "as long as one is worshipping God." there are others that believe that our time together is more a function of "fellowship" rather than worshipping God. Rather than base our conclusions on our own speculation or personal judgements, let's allow the Bible to teach us!

Christians have the teaching of Jesus in the New Testament to direct us. Jesus taught, "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth: for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must in spirit and truth." (Jn. 4:23-24) First of all, consider that God is seeking "true worshippers." That obviously implies that one can be a false worshipper. It also should drive every believer to do whatever is necessary to enable God to **find him** when He is seeking His true worshippers!

There is a standard set out for true worship—it is done "in spirit and in truth." God's Word is "truth." (Jn. 17:17) Read through the New Testament. That early church partook of the Lord's Supper every Sunday (1 Cor. 11:23-26), sang hymns of praise as a congregation (Eph. 5:19), prayed to the Lord (1Cor. 14:14-16). Gave of their means (1Cor. 16:1-2), and enjoyed the preaching of the gospel (2 Tim. 4:2).

The Lord's church will always seek to follow this **authorized** pattern for worship in the New Testament!
