Does It Really Matter

Have you considered what difference it makes to the driver who ignores the signal at the four-way stop? The fact the signs are there seems to make no difference in his/her life. The same holds true for the posted speed limits, wearing seatbelts, and talking on ones cell phone. The law has no impact on that person who chooses to ignore them!

Now consider this. The fact that Jesus came makes no difference in the life of that person who chooses to ignore His presence on the earth.

What difference does it make if Jesus was born of a virgin in Bethlehem? To those who are seeking to find God, the birth of Jesus announced the beginning of God's eternal plan of salvation for mankind. But to that person who makes no changes in his life, it makes no difference. Jesus might as well not have been born. Sad thought isn't it?

What difference does it make if Jesus ever taught any lessons at all? So what if He taught about morality, marriage, self-control, dealing with enemies, prayer, the abundant life and the resurrection? He might as well have not said a single word—if one chooses to ignore Him!
